We are happy to announce that the Bergenfield Music Department will again be offering a Summer Music Workshop under the auspices of the Bergenfield Board of Education. We invite you to send your child to the 2013 Summer Music Workshop for an enjoyable, creative, and instructive summer.

The Bergenfield Summer Music Workshop is available to all instrumentalists (wind/brass/percussion/string) **grades 4-8**. Each child who plays a woodwind/brass/percussion/string instrument will receive a 30-minute small group lesson, and a 30-minute band or orchestra class. We also offer a one hour piano class for those in 4th grade or older, and a one hour guitar class for those in 6th grade or older. Please read the following information very carefully for rules/restrictions and timelines for turning in enrollment forms.

GENERAL INFORMATION

DATES

Classes begin Monday, June 24 and end on Friday, July 19.

TIME

Class times will be scheduled anytime from 8:30am – 12:30pm depending on availability of time slots. If your child wishes to take other summer enrichment courses, every effort will be made to ensure their schedule will not have “gaps” of time. If this cannot be avoided, the Summer Enrichment program offers a waiting room where students can play games, read, and/or watch movies until their next class.

- All band/orchestra students will receive a 30-minute small group lesson, and a 30-minute ensemble.

- Piano and guitar classes are 60 minutes.

TUITION

Tuition for the Summer Music Workshop is \$135.00. Please refer to the enrollment form for a more detailed listing of pricing.

Woodwind and brass students use **Accent on Achievement, while String students use **Essential Elements** and Percussion **Alfred's Book 1**. If you already own the proper book for your grade, you are not required to purchase another copy. Just bring your copy to the first day of summer music.*

ENROLLMENT PERIOD

All summer enrollment forms should be mailed with payment, no later than FRIDAY June 7, 2013. Class sizes are limited, so you are urged to enroll as soon as possible. If a class does not have enough enrolled students to run the class, it will be cancelled and your money refunded.

**Percussion students*

Percussion (drums) students must rent or purchase a percussion kit that includes a drum pad, bell set, drumsticks, and bell mallets. It is highly recommend that you look into purchasing either the Pearl (PK900C), Yamaha (SPK-275R), or Vic Firth (V8806). These bell sets come with higher quality hardware and rolling cases.

**Renting from the school*

There are select school instruments available to rent from the school district. These instruments are available on a first come first serve basis, and there is no guarantee of availability. The only instruments available to rent from the school are – Viola, Cello, String Bass, Oboe, Bassoon, Bass Clarinet, Tenor Sax, Bari Sax, French Horn, Trombone, Baritone, and Tuba. Please contact your primary music teacher for availability.

CLASSES OFFERED

FOURTH GRADE BEGINNING INSTRUMENT SELECTION:

Flute, Clarinet, Trumpet, French Horn, Trombone, Baritone, Percussion (Drums and Mallets), Violin, Viola, Cello & Piano.

FIFTH GRADE BEGINNING INSTRUMENT SELECTION:

All of the above instruments, plus Oboe, Bassoon, Alto Saxophone.

***PLEASE NOTE** Beginning Grade 4 & 5 students who take Summer Music are NOT guaranteed to play in the Winter Concert. Selection to play is strictly based on the student's ability to play the instrument and learn the music.

SIXTH GRADE OR HIGHER INSTRUMENT SELECTION:

All of the above instruments, plus Bass Clarinet, Tenor Saxophone, Baritone Saxophone, Tuba, Guitar and String Bass.

- Experienced students who wish to sign up for two instruments (other than piano and guitar) *must also obtain approval from their school's instrumental music teacher*. Depending on the two instruments being studied and the corresponding level, scheduling is not always possible.

PIANO AND GUITAR: **Piano students** will have a piano at Roy W. Brown to use during class, but must have a piano or electronic keyboard instrument at home to practice their lessons. **Guitar students** should bring a NYLON string classical guitar for the first day of classes. Electric guitars are not permitted. ***Guitar Classes are for students in Grade 6 or higher.**

BERGEN COUNTY AND/OR REGION HELP: If your child would like their 30 minute lesson focused on the current year's Bergen County audition music, or Region I solo please select this option and every effort will be made to ensure your child is placed with students with these same goals in mind. This option is available to incoming 7th or 8th graders.

SUMMER ENRICHMENT CLASSES: The Bergenfield Public Schools also offers academic classes that may include – Animation and Gaming, Chemistry, Creative Writing, Engineering Design and Marketing, ESL Immersion Program, Fashion Focus, Journalism, Mock Trial and others. These classes require a separate application and fee.
